



## **Bring Your Own Device Equity Policy - Conservatorium High**

The Conservatorium High School BYOD program can only function effectively if all students have access to a device that meets the Device Specification in the BYOD and IT Policy.

All BYOD programs involve a cost to users.

To ensure access and equity for all students in years that are part of the BYOD program, the school has established procedures for families to apply for assistance in obtaining access to a device that meets the Device Specification.

Firstly, our BYOD portal lets you create a payment plan when you purchase a device from them.

1. Select Finance Application as your payment method at checkout.
2. Once you have an order confirmation, call FlexiRent on their dedicated Education line 1300 726 110 to discuss a payment plan.
3. Complete the FlexiRent Finance Application over the phone.

If you believe you are still unable to provide a device that meets the specification you may make an application in writing to the Principal, or make an appointment to speak with the Principal, so that your particular case can be outlined. The school's phone number is 02 9351 1350.

While the school won't purchase devices for students in the BYOD program there are several options available to provide assistance to students.

These include:

- Partial subsidy of a Chromebook device if purchased through the BYOD portal
- Loan of a laptop or other device for a particular day
- Recurrent daily loan of a laptop or other device.

You will be asked to make an agreement with the school that confirms the alternative arrangements made for your child's access to a device.
